Director Broadstreet made a motion to approve the bills as presented noting each payee, the dollar amounts, and purpose were read into the March 9, 2026 minutes, Director Blais seconded. Motion carried.

4305 E CR 210— Attorney Bartholomew stated that the homeowner, located at 4305 E. CR 210, Craig Anderson, will be now connecting his home to the garage. Since the BLCD does not have specific building codes, it will refer to the County's Building Code. After some discussion, Vice Chairman Collura made a motion that (1) the issue will not be dismissed until the connection is completed within a time frame given and it has been inspected by the County inspector, (2) the hookup fee will not be refunded in exchange that the fines would be waived, (3) the monthly fee will continue until the County's inspection. Director Blais seconded. Motion carried.

Plant Manager's Report—Plant Manager Jordan reported that there was 0.93 inches of precipitation for February, and the lake pump pumped 0.0 million gallons into the lake. Plant Manager Jordan stated that the JPR Engineering sent the plans to IDEM for the 450 S project sewer extension and waiting on the approval.
