Vice Chairman Collura made a motion to approve the bills as presented noting each payee, the dollar amounts, and purpose were read into May 11, 2026 minutes, Director Blais seconded. Motion carried.

Lake Monitoring Plan—Director Broadstreet presented to the Board a Lake Monitoring Plan from Aquatic Control. This plan would include collecting water samples from various locations between May and September 2026. These samples will be collected for water quality parameters and planktonic algae identification and enumeration. Also, sediment samples will be collected to analyze the phosphorus content. A monthly report will be presented with the data collected and relevant recommendations. For more information the Monitoring Plan will be on the website, and the monthly results will be posted. After some discussion, Vice Chairman Collura made a motion to approve the plan presented by Aquatic Control, Director Blais seconded. Motion carried.

450 S Extension Project—Jones Petrie Rafinski Engineer (JPR), Bob Aloï, presented the Board with specs with a new price. After some discussion, Vice Chairman Collura made a motion to approve the preliminary approval of the plans and specks just for purpose of obtaining the state permit from IDEM in case we decide to move forward but otherwise we are tabling the project for the time being, Director Blais seconded. Motion carried.

Plant Manager’s Report—Plant Manager Jordan reported that there was 6.23 inches of precipitation for April, and the lake pump pumped 31.0 million gallons into the lake. Also, the lake is currently 5.5 inches below the damn. Plant Manager Jordan presented the Board with an invoice from Aquatic Control to treat the north pond at the plant for algae and coon tail. After some discussion, Vice Chairman Collura made a motion to approve the invoice that totaled \$4568, Director Broadstreet seconded. Motion carried.

District Office Coordinator’s Comments— Office Coordinator Dillner stated that 23 liens were filed in April for a total of \$6,259.11.

Attorney’s Comments Attorney Bartholomew stated that the homeowner located at 4305 E CR 210 has finished the attached garage. Plant Manager Jordan stated that he would reach out to the County Inspector inspect the attached garage. Attorney Bartholomew stated that he would draw up documents to close the claim as soon as the final County inspection was approved and the Board agreed.

Comments from the Board—Director Broadstreet mentioned that Aquatic Control will be at the lake on May 19th to do the lake survey and the first of five water test to start the Lake Monitoring Plan. Director Broadstreet stated that the lake is currently at 61 degrees.

Comments from the Audience—Audience member discussed that he had a large sink hole from Surf hitting the wastewater line. Discussion took place to help resolve this.

Adjournment--Vice Chairman Collura made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Director Broadstreet seconded. Motion carried. The next meeting will be on June 8, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. CST at the BLPOA building.
