- C. Pump Director Broadstreet reported he had a freeholder come to his home about the pump being on and open water around it. Director Broadstreet had the pump shut off immediately. Director Mix suggested possibly warning signs be installed. Director Collura volunteered to look into signs.
- D. Plant Manager Compensation After complements and some discussion, Director Mix made a motion to increase his contract by 3 ½ percent, seconded by Director Broadstreet, motion carried. This would be immediately and retro-active to January 1, 2014.

MAINTENANCE REPORT

• Plant Manager Jordan reported there was 2.57 inched of rain for December with a total of 38.45 inches for the year 2013. The pump put out 31 million gallons of water for the month of December with 443 million gallons for the year 2013. Discharge was made one time this year and it was 1.6 million gallons.
